TOWNSHIP OF SPRING ARBOR ORDINANCE NO. 29-B OCCASIONAL SALES OF HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF SPRING ARBOR

Whereas, it is necessary to establish criteria for the regulation of occasional sales of household goods and personal property within the Township;

Now, therefore, be it obtained and enacted by the Township Board of the Township of Spring Arbor, County of Jackson, State of Michigan, as follows;

- 1. Occasional sales of household goods and personal property shall be permitted within the Township.
- 2. Such occasional sales, whether they be designated as yard sales, garage sales, porch sales, moving sales, basement sales, or house or personal goods sales, shall not be held to any premises more often than once every ninety (90) days.
- 3. In no case shall any such sale exceed four (4) days in duration.

The foregoing Ordinance shall be published once, in full, in the Jackson Citizen Patriot, a newspaper of general circulation within the boundaries of the Township and qualified under State law to publish legal notices, promptly after its adoption, and the same shall be recorded in the Ordinance book of the Township and such recording authenticated by the signature of the Supervisor and Township Clerk.
